2013 – 2014

Elementary Schools: Average academic kindergarten through fifth grade class size as of September 30, 2013 is 20.4 students per home base class. The average for 2012-2013 was reported at 20.5 for grades K-5.

There were no classes with 30 or more students for 2013-2014.

Middle Schools: Average academic class size as of September 30, 2013 is 24.12 students per class, up from 22.41 in 2012-2013. The total number of academic classes with 30 or more students is 180 for 2013-2014.

High Schools: Average academic class size as of September 30, 2013 is 23.5 students per class, down from 24.3 in 2012-2013. The total number of academic classes with over 30 students is 270 for 2013-2014.
