

Hampstead Police Department
Monthly Report
Town Council Meeting
December 13, 2016

- Traffic Safety: HPD officers issued 155 citations and warnings in November. There were 5 traffic crashes reported. 1 occurred on Main Street, 1 at the Traffic Circle at Rt. 482 and 3 on side streets.

- Community Involvement- HPD officers conducted 183 patrol checks at businesses, parks and schools. During November HPD officers were involved with the following meetings and events:
 - PFC. Cranshaw attended a "Positive Behavior" Pep Rally at Hampstead Elementary School.
 - Sgt. Swartz and Pfc. Cranshaw assisted with "Iggy's Trip to the Police Station" A documentary was created to show to Spring Garden Elementary students. Iggy is the school mascot.
 - Pfc. Cranshaw and Cpl. Holland attended the Drug Awareness Seminar at Shiloh

Middle School. Pfc. Cranshaw was a presenter.

- Lt. Gaegler and Pfc. Thorn attended a Veteran's Day celebration at the North Carroll Senior Center
- Chief Meekins attended a Veteran's Day Celebration at the Westminster American Legion.
- HPD partnered with area restaurants to raise funds for Shop With a Cop.
- Pfc. Wynkoop participated with the Hampstead Elementary School Local Government Field Trip to Town Hall

- Serious Crime: During November there were no burglaries and only 1 theft reported. It was reported that a co-resident of the house stole a pressure washer from the victim, who is the suspect's mother's live-in boyfriend.
- There were 5 Arrests in November; all 5 were adults. Charges included Domestic Assault (2), CDS Possession (2) and Traffic Charges (1). Pfc. Wynkoop participated in a multi-agency warrant sweep where 32 arrests were made on open warrants served countywide.

- K-9 Activity- Our K-9 Team remains in training in Baltimore City. It appears that the training will be completed within the next week.
