


Building Permits

Every building permit for new construction (including sheds and other accessory structures) must have a scale drawing on a plat of the property. This is an example of a scale drawing:



Normally, you can find a copy of your plat in your real estate records. If you cannot, a copy can be obtained from the Carroll County Land Records in the Circuit Court building. A plat is essentially a scale map or drawing of your property. Photocopying a plat may alter the scale slightly. You can check by simply measuring a defined distance on the plat against the scale. To do a drawing, you can use an engineer's scale.
