On Saturday, October 26th, 2013 The Hampstead Police Department and the Drug Enforcement Administration will collaborate to help remove potentially dangerous controlled substances and other medications from our community. This is a great opportunity for those who missed the previous events, or who have subsequently accumulated unwanted, unused and expired prescription drugs, to safely dispose of those medications.

You may bring prescriptions and over-the-counter medications to the **Hampstead Police Department** on **Saturday, October 26th, between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.** Drop-offs may be made anonymously. Removal of all labeling is encouraged. Please take advantage of this opportunity to remove these substances from your drawers and medicine cabinets.

Intravenous solutions, injectables and syringes will not be accepted due to potential hazard posed by blood-borne pathogens.
